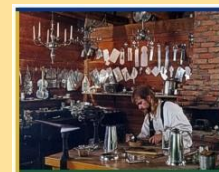
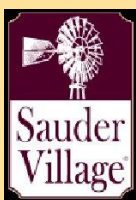


TINSMITH & COPPERSMITH CONVERGENCE
